Eurostat produces European statistics in partnership with National Statistical Institutes and other national authorities in the EU Member States. This partnership is known as the European Statistical System (ESS). It also includes the statistical authorities of the European Economic Area (EEA) countries and Switzerland.

Eurostat is a general directorate of the European Commission and serves as the Statistical Office of the European Union and is also. Its main objective is to provide high quality statistics for Europe. These are also referred to as Official Statistics. Their quality has many dimensions among which: timeliness, punctuality, frequency (etc).
