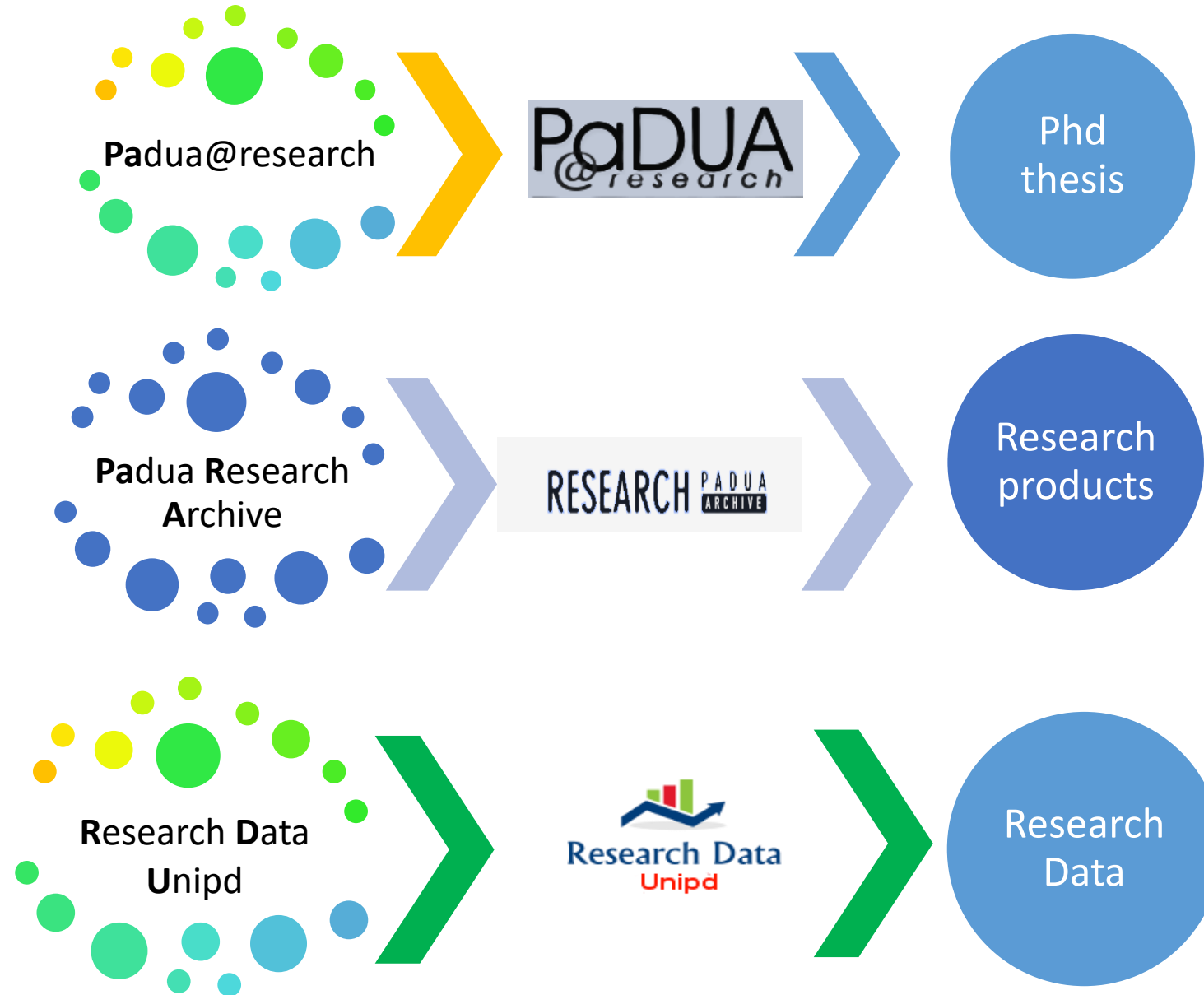
Zenodo is an archive for publications and data, **open to all researchers in the world**.

It is **managed by CERN for OpenAIRE (EU)** and enables self-archiving also to researchers whose institution can't provide an institutional repository or doesn't allow the archive of certain kinds of formats (such as source code and open data).

Main features:

- Assignment of a digital object identifier (DOI)
- Possibility of identifying any subsidies, as they are integrated into the reporting lines for research funded by the European Commission, through OpenAIRE.
- Possibility of assigning flexible guarantees of use, since not everything is under Creative Commons.
- The search results are stored securely in the same cloud infrastructure as CERN's LHC search data.

PRA (IRIS): the best place ...



- # to increase the visibility of research conducted at the University of Padova;
- # to increase the relevance of scientific contributions in international consideration and encourage the comparison of ideas and positions;



- # to increase efficiency in obtaining data and documents, thanks to specialized indexing;
- # to centralize document management in a single collector and thereby avoid the dispersion of resources in local repositories;



- # to guarantee the integrity of documents and their appropriate description, regardless of technological and instrumental changes;



- # to respond to funders requirements, since in many cases they expect the submission of research products to open access repositories.

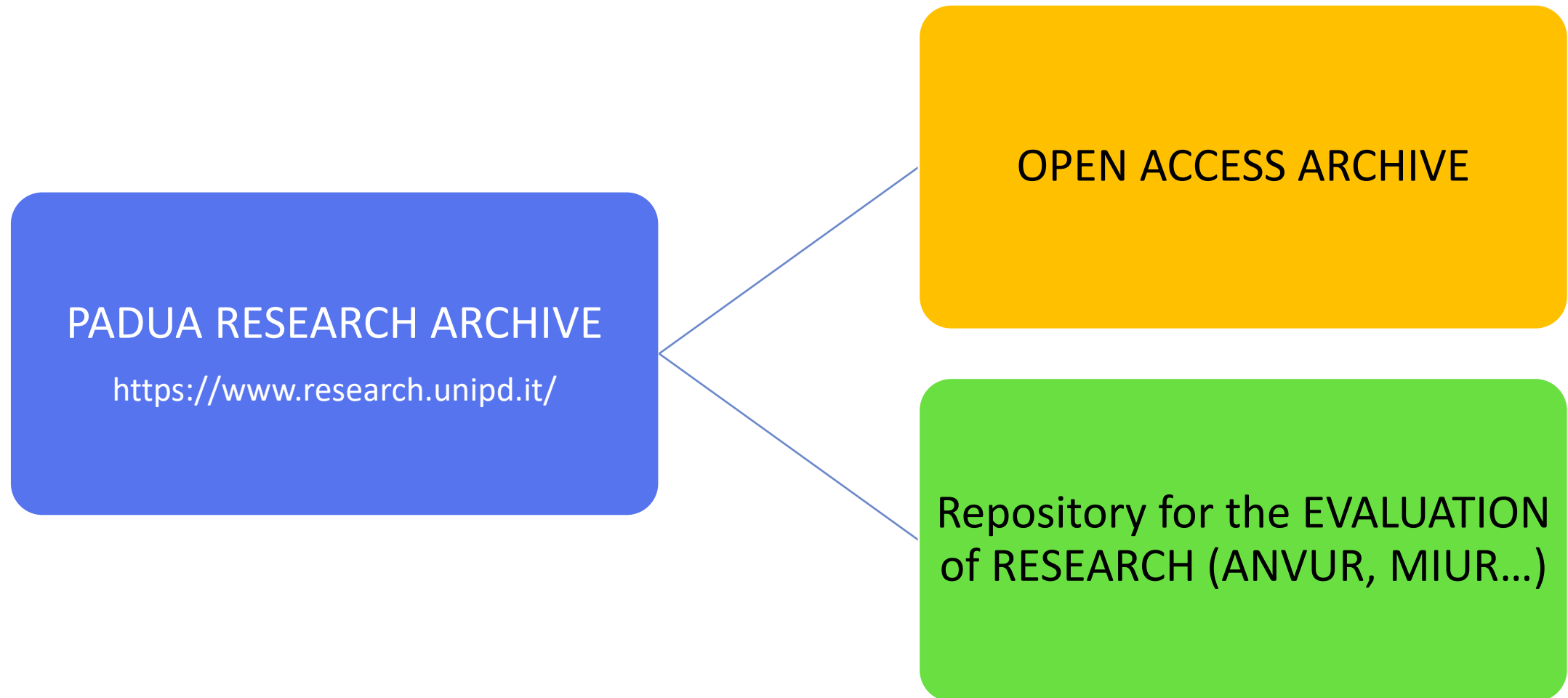

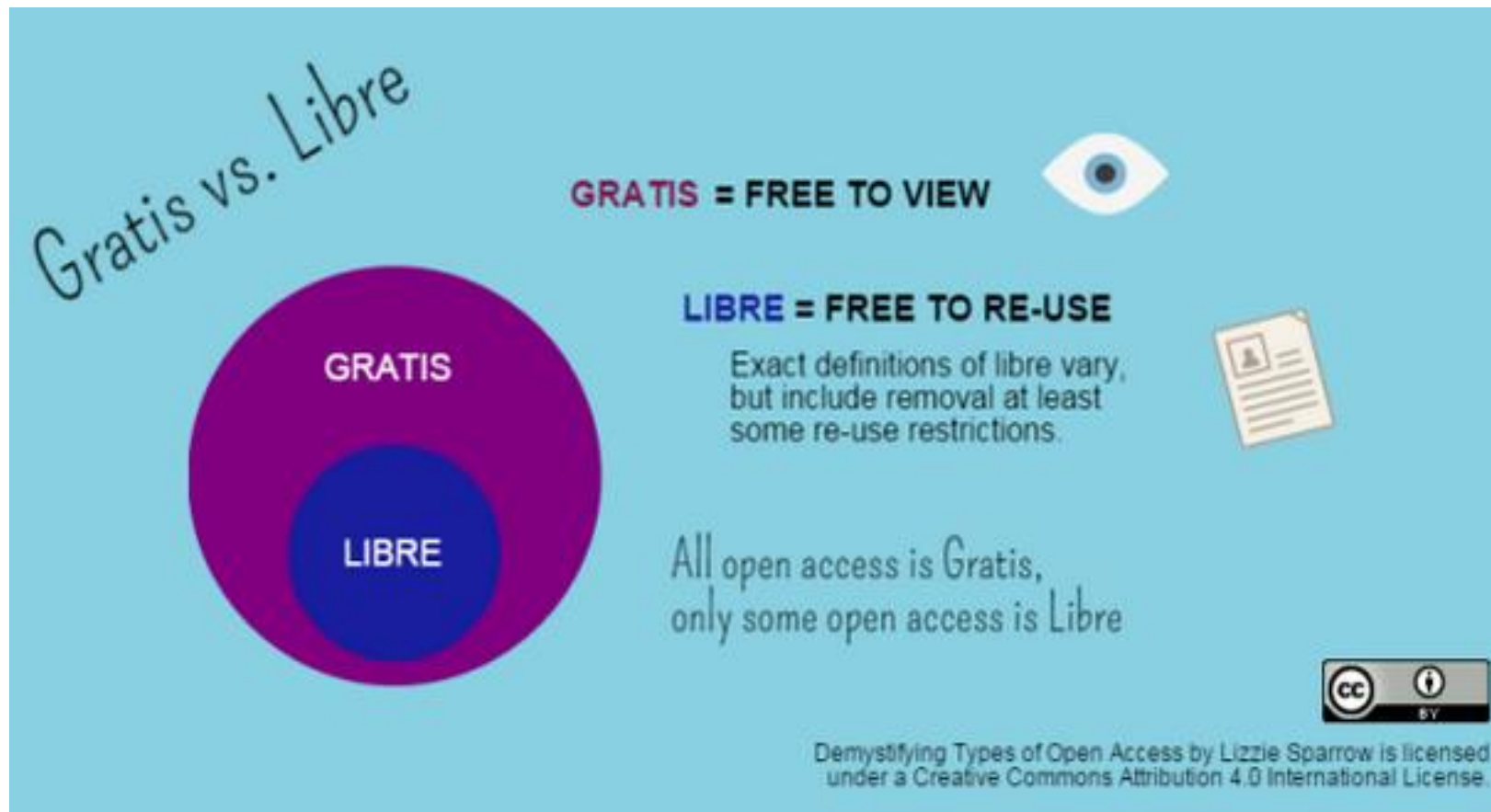

Motivations to apply an embargo

1. Refusal of the publisher, as explained in the Sherpa-Romeo database, or attestation made by the publisher
2. Documented refusal of one of the co-authors, if not belonging to the University
3. Reasons for public or national security
4. Reasons for privacy or presence of sensitive data
5. Protection of the University's economic rights
6. Industrial secret

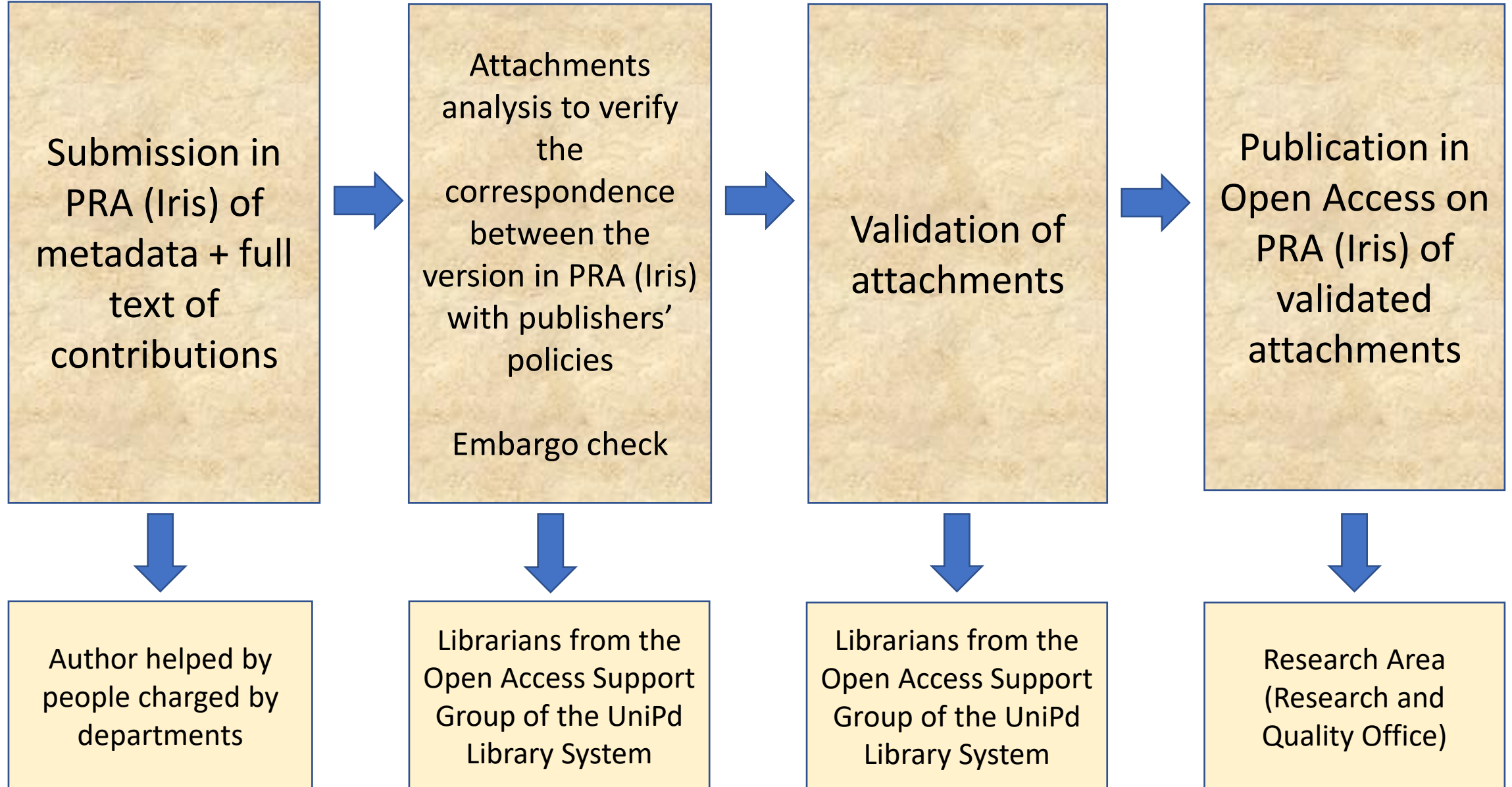
