

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# What is **Zotero**?

**Free, open-source reference management software**

- . Developed by the Corporation for Digital Scholarship
- . Available for Windows, Mac, Linux
- . Works offline with optional cloud sync (300 MB free)
- . Community-driven with 10,000+ citation styles

# Why researchers choose it?

- ✓ Captures sources with one click
- ✓ Organizes research materials efficiently
- ✓ Generates citations automatically
- ✓ Collaborates seamlessly with teams

# Collecting References: Three ways to add items to your library:

## 1. **Browser Connector** (most popular)

- Automatically detects PDFs, articles, books, webpages
- Saves metadata + full-text PDF when available
- Works on: PubMed, JSTOR, Google Scholar, library catalogs

## 2. **Manual Entry**

- Click green "+" button → select item type
- Fill in metadata fields

## 3. **Import from File**

- Drag & drop PDFs (Zotero retrieves metadata)
- Import .RIS, .BibTeX, .EndNote files

# Organizing Your Library: Smart organization tools

## **Collections** (folders)

- Create unlimited nested collections
- Same item can appear in multiple collections
- Right-click → "New Collection«

## **Tags**

- Automatic tags from databases
- Manual tags (color-code up to 9 tags)
- Filter library instantly

## **Related Items**

- Link conceptually connected sources

# Citing While You Write: Word processor integration

## **Microsoft Word / LibreOffice / Google Docs**

1. Install the plugin from Zotero preferences
2. Write your document
3. Click "Add/Edit Citation" in Zotero toolbar
4. Search and insert citation
5. Click "Add/Edit Bibliography" → automatic formatting

## **Key features:**

- Switch citation styles instantly (APA → MLA → Chicago)
- Updates automatically when you modify items
- Handles in-text citations + footnotes + endnotes

**For LaTeX users:** Export to BibTeX/BibLaTeX

# Reading & Annotating: Built-in PDF reader

- **Highlight** text in multiple colors
- **Add notes** directly on PDFs
- **Extract annotations** to separate notes automatically
- **Search within PDFs** across your entire library

## Notes feature:

- Standalone notes or child notes attached to items
- Rich text formatting
- Link notes to multiple sources
- Export notes to Markdown

# Citation Styles: 10,000+ styles in the repository

## Popular academic styles:

- APA 7th edition
- Chicago Manual of Style
- IEEE
- Nature
- Vancouver

## Find & install:

1. Edit → Preferences → Cite → "Get additional styles"
2. Search by name or discipline
3. Click to install

# Collaboration Features: Share research with your team

## **Group Libraries:**

- Private groups (invitation only)
- Public groups (open or closed membership)
- Shared collections with editing permissions

## **Storage options:**

- Free: 300 MB
- Unlimited: for a fee

## **Use cases:**

- Research teams working on joint publications

# Advanced Tips: Maximize your efficiency

## Duplicate Detection

- Zotero → Duplicate Items → Merge automatically

## DOI/ISBN/PMID Import

- Click magic wand icon → paste identifier → retrieve metadata

## Plugins Ecosystem

- Better BibTeX (enhanced LaTeX workflow)
- Zotero Connector enhancements
